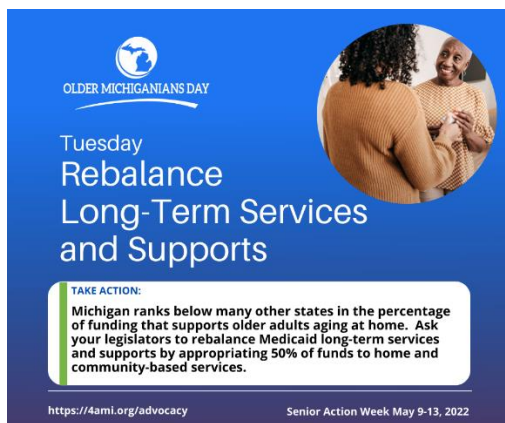

Post 1: Monday



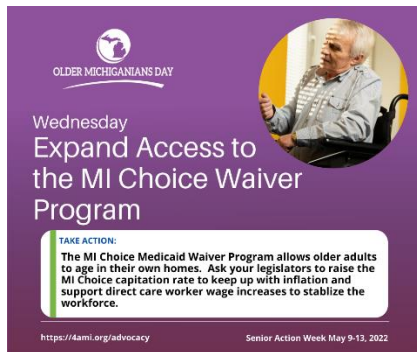

Post 2: Tuesday



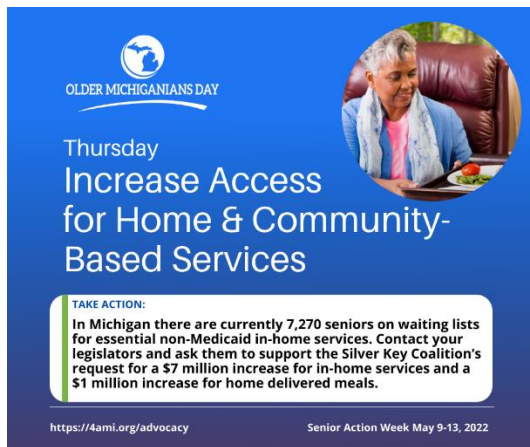
